We have received a grant from the Manitoba Law Foundation to coordinate 32 legal workshops for women on basic information, resources and education. The workshops will be focused on community women and/or service providers. They will take place at one of our 3 locations: 1150A Waverley Street, #104-3100 Pembina Hwy or #104-210 Ellen Street (at Ross).

Topics areas could include but are not limited to:

- Issues around Family Law – Access, Child Custody, Domestic Violence, Spousal Support, Family Property Issues
- Legal Issues for Older Women i.e. - Wills & Estates
- Women's Rights, Working with a lawyer, How does Court Work, Legal information women should know
- Issues around Human Rights, Equality Rights and Poverty Law
- We are also open to hearing possible topic areas of workshops from interested facilitators.

Workshops are currently being coordinated and will finish late spring 2010.
