

HOW TO GET LEGAL ADVICE AND APPLY FOR LEGAL AID

Legal Aid Manitoba offers a drop-in legal clinic where you may obtain free legal advice and apply for Legal Aid coverage, if necessary.

Advice is provided free of charge to everybody and is on a "First Come - First Serve" basis only. There are no appointments taken.

HOW:

If you are not in receipt of social allowances there is a \$25.00 application fee. This fee must be paid in cash, or by certified cheque, or money order at the time of application.

Helpful Hints:

- ▶ Bring all documentation relating to your case that you may have in your possession to the interview.
 - ▶ If you know your court dates and times, write them down and ensure you tell the interviewer.
 - ▶ Bring pay stubs from your employer, and/or a copy of a tax return for the previous year to the interview. If you are in receipt of social allowances, bring an assistance statement with you should you need to apply for Legal Aid. This will speed the application process and help the interviewer determine your eligibility.
